

CHRISTMAS BALDERDASH

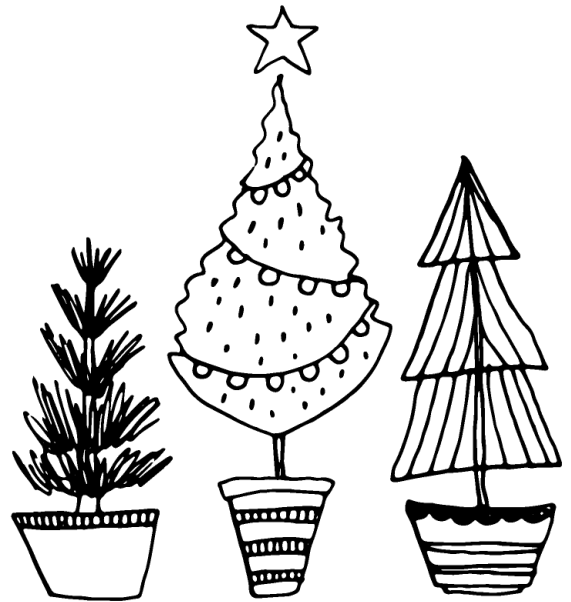
Players: 4+

Materials:

- Writing utensil
- Pads of paper for each player
- Christmas Balderdash cards

How to Play:

1. Each player takes paper and a writing utensil and decides who will be the first reader.
2. The reader takes a card and reads the category and question. The categories are Words, People, and Movies.
 - a. Words – What is the definition of this word?
 - b. People – What is this person known for?
 - c. Movies – What is the basic storyline?
3. Each player makes up an answer and writes it on their paper. The reader takes the correct answer provided on the card and writes it down as well.
4. When all answers are in, the reader then reads all responses, including the correct answer, in a random order. Each player then chooses which response they believe is the correct answer.
 - a. Players score one point for every vote their response gets.
 - b. Players score one point for guessing the correct answer.
 - c. Players score two points if their response closely resembles the correct answer.
 - d. The reader scores two points if none of the players guess the correct answer.
5. After finishing the round, the person to the left of the reader becomes the next reader. They pick a card and play continues until a player earns 15 points.
